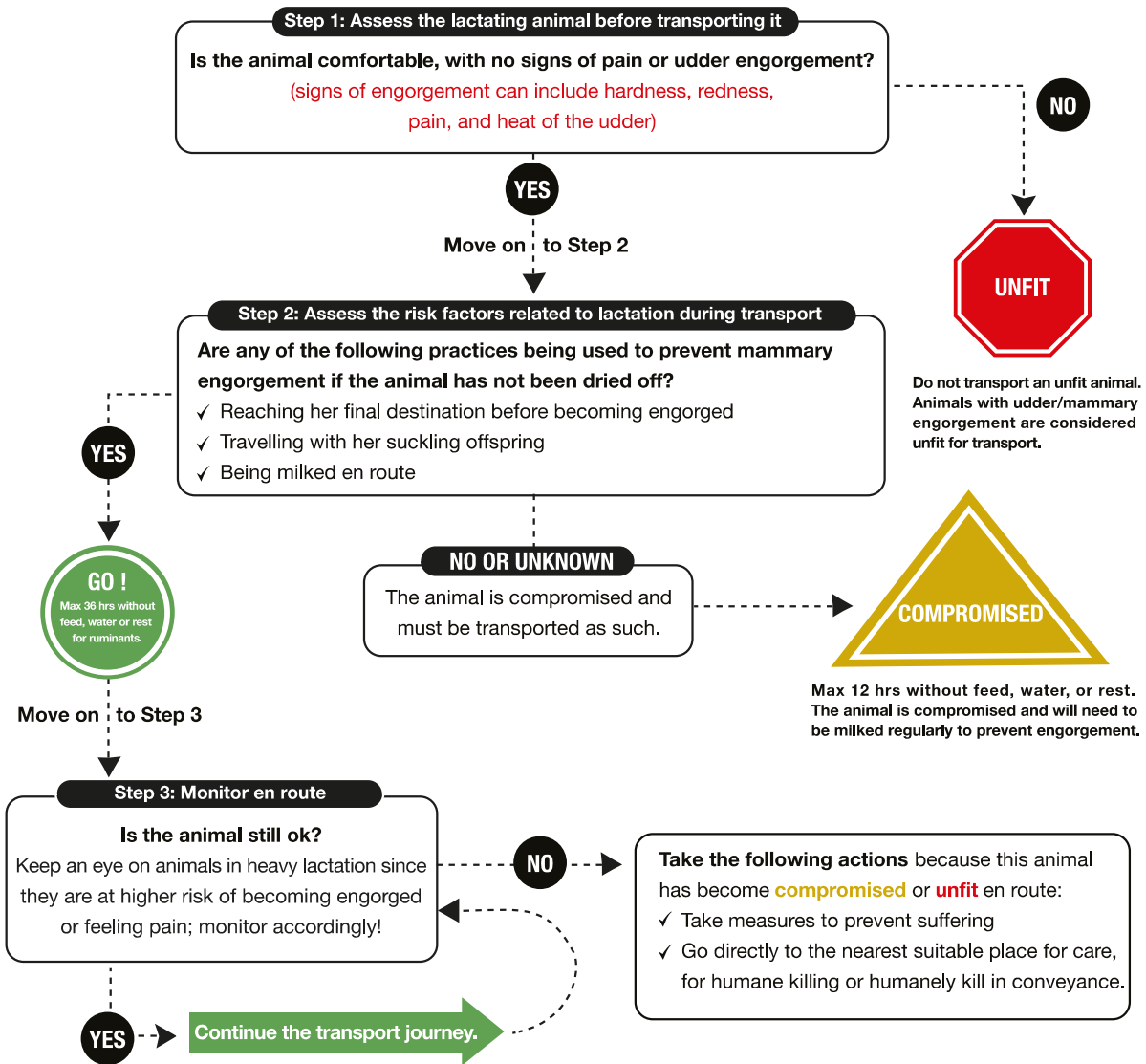


TRANSPORTING LACTATING ANIMALS

DEFINITIONS

 **UNFIT**

An unfit animal can only be transported directly to a place to receive veterinary care and under the recommendation of a veterinarian.

 **COMPROMISED**

A compromised animal can only be transported directly for slaughter or to a place to receive care for its condition. It cannot be transported to an assembly centre or auction market.

 **REQUIREMENTS**

if transporting an **unfit** or **compromised** animal

- Isolate the animal
- Load or unload the animal alone without negotiating interior ramps
- Take special measures to prevent unnecessary suffering
